**RE: Correction of Publishing Error, Location of KSM TMF on Map Contained within the Fall Issue of RAVENCALL**

With respect to your fall issue of the RAVENCALL magazine, I want to take this opportunity to point out a publishing error that is contained within the “Water Knows No Boundaries” map that is presented on pages 6 and 7 of the magazine. On this map, the location of the KSM TMF (#7 of the map legend) is identified as being located in the Unuk watershed, while the KSM Project (#9 of the map legend) is identified as being located within the Bell Irving watershed. That is unfortunately incorrect, as the KSM TMF is located within the Bell Irving watershed which **does not** flow into Alaska. The KSM mineral deposits are located on tributaries of the Unuk River (Sulphurets and Mitchell creeks), which does flow into Alaska. We request a public correction of this error as such misinformation does a disservice to the provision of accurate information regarding the KSM Project.

I have attached a copy of the publically available Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency’s Comprehensive Study Report for the KSM Project to this letter for informational purposes. The KSM project components, including location, are clearly identified within Figures 2.1.1 and 2.1.2, pages 5 and 7 respectfully, of this document. Furthermore, this document, highlights that Alaska’s transboundary concerns with respect to fish and water quality were assessed and addressed during the independent environmental assessment review for the KSM Project which concluded in December 2014 (please refer to the Executive Summary page III and Transboundary Concerns page 91 of the document).
