
KSM MINING ULC


KSM is one of the largest undeveloped gold-copper projects in the world and is classified as a multi-generational asset. Since 2006, more than \$650+ million has been spent on exploration, engineering, development and environmental work to responsibly advance the KSM Project. In 2014, the KSM Project received Environmental Assessment (EA) approvals from both the Provincial and the Federal governments. In 2021, Seabridge started undertaking early-stage construction activities such as building camps, roads and site preparation work to achieve 'Substantially Started' status by July 28, 2026. KSM Mining ULC, a subsidiary of Seabridge Gold Inc., is the holder of the KSM Project.
