The Community Donation Program has an intake season from February 1st through to November 30th of each year. Applications can be submitted at any time during the intake. Applications received outside the intake will be asked to resubmit during the following intake.

Requests for Community Donations are reviewed monthly, and responses can generally be expected in the first week of the following month. If you are successful, you will be requested to complete a Donation Acceptance Form which should be submitted right away and no later than December 15th. Donations need to be processed within the calendar year of their approval. Once we receive the Acceptance Form, it will take approximately 30 days for your organization to receive payment.

- Would this donation violate any of the constraints outlined in Seabridge's Community Sponsorship and Donation Policy?

The following will not be considered for funding:

- Organizational operating expenses including salaries, utilities, and overhead costs
- Religious or sectarian organizations (except where they provide non-denominational community and social support services)
- Political organizations, political events, and candidates for elected office
- For-profit organizations
- Endowments or debt reduction campaigns
- Events and activities that take place outside of the region
- Retroactive requests
- Donations benefiting an individual person rather than an organization.
