## Key Responsibilities

- Performing wildlife pre-disturbance surveys in advance of drilling activities (birds, mammals, amphibians). The candidate would be experienced with British Columbia wildlife survey protocols, requirements for pre-disturbance surveys, and able to identify birds by sight and sound.
- Performing monitoring tasks in various disciplines if required (wildlife, birds, fish, aquatic habitat, water quality, vegetation, soils, wetlands, environmental monitoring, sediment, and erosion control).
- Travelling and working in remote locations for extended periods of time.
- Navigating with GPS / compass through difficult and challenging terrain with minimal helicopter support.
- Driving to multiple sites depending on project requirement.

## Education, Skills and Experience

- B.Sc. in Biology, Natural Resource Management or related discipline with 10+ years of experience in similar field.

- Experience working on industrial projects in a similar role.
- Registered Professional Biologist or Professional Biologist designation
- Sound knowledge of field techniques and regulatory standards necessary for conducting a variety of field activities (i.e., wildlife assessments, bird surveys, water quality, fisheries inventories/ salvage, environmental monitoring/inspection). Specific knowledge of survey techniques for raptors, songbirds, furbearers, bats, amphibians (western toad), marmots, pikas,

- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
