The projects are located in remote environments, and the role will include working all weather conditions and challenging terrain.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist geologists with geotechnical data collection from diamond drill core
- Assist with drill core sampling
- Assist in the collection and recording of other rock properties such as magnetic susceptibility, orientation data, and geochemical information
- Data entry and management using Acquire, Excel and other software
- Load drill core into core logging facility and other general labour activities as required
- Assist in the collection of geological information that requires an understanding of geologic principles
- Perform other duties as assigned
- Follow and uphold Seabridge Health, Safety, Sustainability and Environmental standards and codes in all aspects of role.
